## Organics

(Must be separated into the following two groups)

### Group 1

- Yardwaste (leaves, grass, weeds, etc.)
- Prunings
- Brush
- Small Dimensional Tree Materials
- Palm Fronds and Bamboo
- Palm & Yucca Trunks (up to 18” length & 12” diameter)

### Group 2

- Clean Framing and Decking Lumber
- Clean Construction Wood Debris
- Plywood & Pallets
- Wood Crates and Cable Spools
- Logs and Tree Trunks (without root ball)
- Diseased Pine and Oak Materials

### All woodwaste must be FREE OF THE FOLLOWING:

- No Pressure Treated or Painted Lumber
- No Particle Board, Chipboard, MDF or OSB
- No Pampas Grass
- No Cape Ivy
- No Poison Oak
- No Refuse
- No Plastic Bags
- No Plastics including Combustables
- No Paper
- No Petroleum Contaminated Wood
- No Metal/Hardware (unless less than 1/4” diameter)
- No Rootballs
- No Oversized Palm & Yucca runks
- No Dirt, Rock, Concrete or Bone
- No Hazardous Waste
- No Putrescent Wastes (fruit & meat)

## Construction and Debris Boxes

Except for demolition projects, everything must be separated besides Untreated wood, Metals and Cardboard)

- Untreated Wood
- Concrete Asphalt
- Brick
- Porcelain Goods
- Tile
- Metals
- Sheetrock
- Wood Shake Shingles
- Carpet and Padding
- Cardboard
- Clean Plastic Film
